

Superintendent's Message

ATTENTION Special Warning

Do you have...solar lights, fences, statuary, signs, saddles, memorabilia, artificial or natural flowers at our cemetery on grave spaces or in the mausoleums? The Board of Directors reminds you of the semi-annual Cemetery Clean Up that will begin the day after Thanksgiving, November 23, 2012. <u>Everything</u>, will be removed-no exceptions.

- You may place winter decorations on graves and in mausoleums starting December 1, 2012.
- Winter decorations will be removed after February 28, 2013 from all grave spaces and mausoleums.
- Due to weather at this time of year, please do not place Spring decorations until March 15, 2013.

From its inception, David's Cemetery has been a work in progress, starting as a small country cemetery to what you see today. We have strived to beautify and improve the cemetery to meet the wants and needs of our families, neighbors and future generations. Every step along the way, over many years, we have gained insights into what worked and what fell short. We have continuously improved; using new techniques and ideas to meet the demands of our families, while striving to make sure it is beneficial to the cemetery.

Today, once again, we find ourselves checking our assumptions against a shifting world, tested to keep up with a society that never sits still. In the span of a generation, communication technology has fundamentally altered the way people acquire, absorb and share information. Computers in tablets and smart phones possess powers that were inconceivable 20 years ago. It is a new world. Yet with all this easy, instant access to knowledge, we see a concurrent decline in awareness and compassion for our fellow man, which some have described as "cultural amnesia".


